Section Leader

Assistant Section Leader (Silk)

- When in full ensemble block on silk, works with the captain in the running of warmups, routines and duties, as directed by the staff.
- When in full ensemble block on weapon, supports the assistant captain and captain in their running of the respective duties.
- When in split ensemble, carries out the directions given by the staff.
- Reports to captain any problems or issues.
- Works hand in hand with captain in assuring that instructions are carried out.
- Supports both the captain and assistant captain, as well as the ensemble & staff in all endeavors and decisions, even if there is a disagreement or difference in opinions.
- Maintains a positive attitude at all times pertaining to guard, both in and outside of the ensemble.

Assistant Section Leader (Weapon)

- When in full ensemble block on weapon, works with the captain in running of warmups, routines and duties, as directed by the staff.
- When in full ensemble block on silk, supports the assistant captain and captain in their running of the respective duties.
- When in split ensemble, carries out directions given by the staff.
- Reports to captain any problems or issues.
- Works hand in hand with the captain in assuring that instructions are carried out.
- Supports both the captain and assistant captain, as well as the ensemble & staff in all endeavors and decisions, even if there is a disagreement or difference in opinions.
